
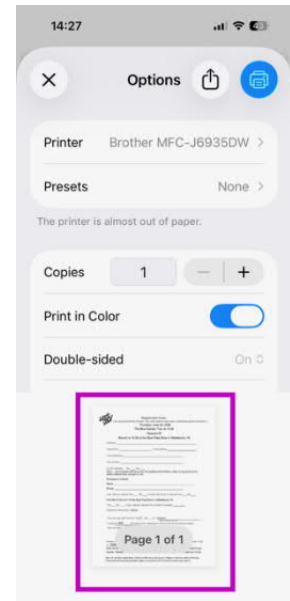


Filling out a registration form on an Apple iPhone or iPad*

1. Open the form link from the Quill. At the bottom, you will see constantcontact.com, and to the right, three dots.
(If you don't see 3 dots, tap the constantcontact.com address at the bottom once. The dots should appear at the bottom right.)



2. Tap the three dots (...).
3. Tap Share (square with arrow pointing up)
 Share
4. Scroll down and select Print. (You may have to scroll down a bit.)
5. You will see something like the screen on the right. Notice the miniature page preview of the registration (shown here with a purple square around it).
6. Pinch outward with two fingers on the page preview until it fills the page. (You may have to tap it first.)
7. Tap Preview at the bottom.



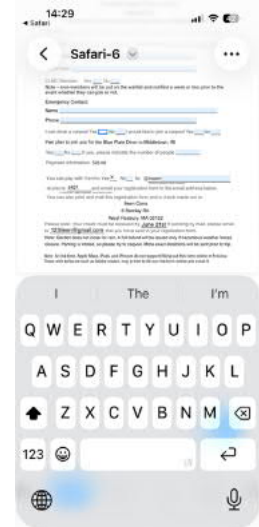
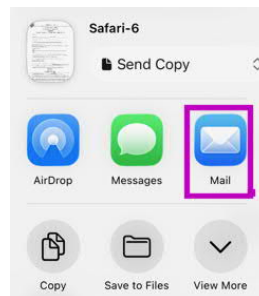
8. Tap the AutoFill icon at the top left to activate the interactive fields.



9. Fill out the form. (The fields should be blue, and when you click on a field, the keyboard should appear at the bottom of the screen.)
10. When done filling out the form, tap the form anywhere but *not* on a highlighted blue field. The keyboard should disappear, and you should see the following icons at the bottom of the screen.



11. Tap the share icon (indicated by the purple rectangle).
12. That should bring up options for sending a copy of the registration. Tap the Mail envelope to send it to the address identified on the form.



*Apparently, this extra workaround is needed because Apple turned off normal form-filling in standard Preview mode due to security issues. If you encounter issues with an Apple Mac, this procedure may also work. Eventually, Apple may solve the security problem, allowing form-filling in standard Preview mode.
